We're thrilled that you're interested in joining us at the Second Annual Greenfield Lake Cypress Festival. Following are some answers to some questions you may have about exhibiting with us at the Festival.

DATE & TIME: Saturday, September 26th 11:00am – 7:00pm. Rain date is Sunday the 27th.

Vehicle access to the amphitheater site will be available starting at 9:00am. All set-up must be complete and vehicles removed by 10:45am. Vehicles will not be allowed on site until 6pm. Festival volunteers will assist you in moving your vehicle in and out of the festival area.

PLACE: The Cypress Festival will take place at the Greenfield Lake Amphitheater, off W. Lake Shore Drive in Wilmington, NC. The recently renovated 900 seat amphitheater and its landscaped grounds sit beneath the cypress and long leaf pine on the banks of Wilmington's Greenfield Lake.

EXHIBITORS/VENDORS:

A limited number of 10'x10' vendor spaces are available to relevant exhibitors and vendors at very modest cost. Relevant exhibitors and vendors include:

- (a) *kindred spirits* - local or regional environmental non-profit organizations, government agencies or public/private partnerships for whom protecting and conserving the environment is a major activity.
- (b) *environmental artists* – local or regional artists whose work features an environmental or conservation theme.
- (c) *green business* – commercial businesses or publications with a strong environmental component or whose products or services may be of particular interest to environmentalists or conservationists

We are not able to offer space to food vendors of any kind – no matter how tasty or how organic – at this time.

VENDOR FEES:

The standard fee for a 10'x10' exhibit space for the day is \$50, payable in advance.

Exhibiting artists may donate a piece of artwork with a value of at least \$50 (to be included in a silent auction at the Festival) in lieu of payment. Donated art pieces must be pre-approved.

Kindred Spirit organizations may have their exhibit fees waived in exchange for selling at least 10 (ten) individual Cypress Festival Tickets prior to the festival.

Vendor fees include 1 festival admission. All exhibitors must have at least one person manning your space at all times.

Sponsors: A very limited number of premium exhibit spaces are available to major sponsors of the Cypress Festival. If you would like more information about becoming a Festival Sponsor contact Carrie Frohling at CFRW (910-762-5606, carrie@cfrw.us)

A rough map of the Festival location is attached with exhibitor locations marked. Indicate any location preference on the vendor application. This map is a rough guide ONLY and subject to change. While we try to meet all location requests, final vendor/exhibitor locations are purely at the discretion of Cape Fear River Watch.

Vendors may be asked to remove any items inappropriate for or inconsistent with the nature of the Festival.

All fees are due with application. Those not accepted will be returned their checks.

Collection and reporting of North Carolina Sales Tax is the responsibility of the Vendor.

Vendor will be charged for any grounds damage, or for clean up necessitated by painting, oil, grease, or for excessive debris left in the vendor's space.

Cape Fear River Watch reserves the right to use photographs and video taken of vendor, vendor's booth and personnel. These photographs may be used to promote the Festival.

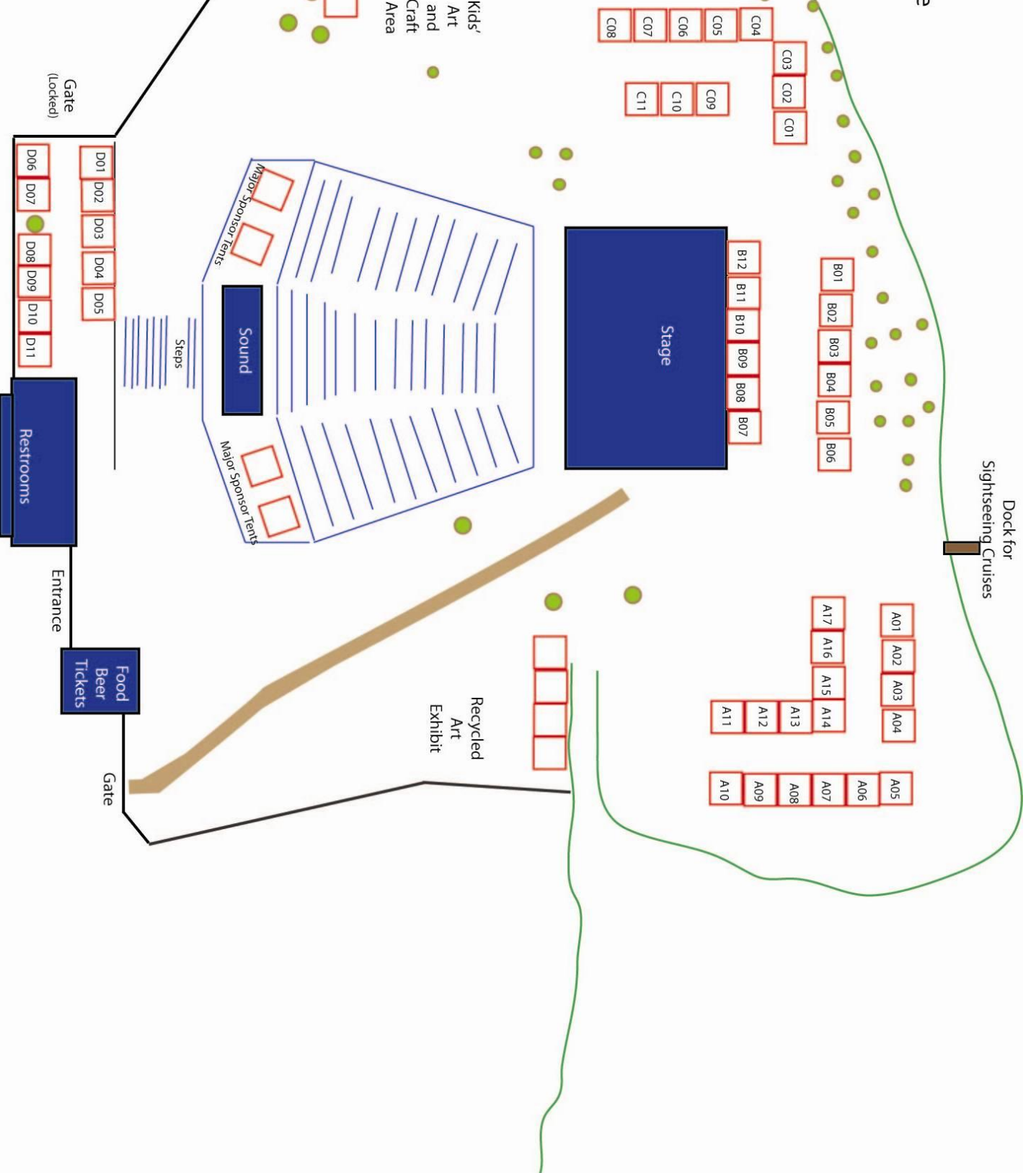
